We have the technology and resources to provide the quality care and exceptional services both you and your pet deserve. It is our mission to keep your best friend as safe and as comfortable as possible during his or her stay with us. We understand that you want better than average!

What We Offer to All Surgical Patients

Pre-Surgical Exam - To ensure the health and safety of your pet, we will conduct a complete physical exam prior to surgery or the administration of any anesthetic; this will help to rule out any undetected fever or minor illness that may be present.

Pre-Anesthetic Medication - Our custom of administering a sedative or tranquilizer prior to anesthetization is much better for your pet; not only does it allow for less of the general anesthetic to be used, but it also makes post-anesthetic recovery smoother.

IV Catheter - Following pre-anesthetic sedation, an intravenous (IV) catheter is placed into a vein, where it serves as a ready lifeline providing instant access to your pet's blood stream should any fluids or drugs need to be administered during surgery.

Gas/Inhalant Anesthesia - Modern day inhalant anesthetics, such as the Isoflurane that we use, are a vast improvement over the older anesthetics, not only in safety but in induction and recovery time as well.

Fluids - Fluids are administered to our patients during surgery; this will help any pet with a minor organ system dysfunction better handle the anesthetic.

Heated Surgery Table - Thanks to our heated surgery table, we are able to keep all of our surgical patients warm and comfortable during their operation.

Pre-Operative Pain Medication - Pain control is administered to our surgical patients prior to their operation, based on individual anticipated need.

Electronic Monitoring - Besides constant human evaluation, we provide vigilant electronic monitoring of vital signs such as respiration, blood pressure, and heart rate during surgery, allowing for rapid detection of and response to any potentially critical changes in heart or lung function.

Additional Services Available:

Pre-Surgical Bloodwork - Because no surgery is without risk, we strongly recommend running bloodwork prior to surgery in order to minimize the likelihood of any anesthesia-related complications.

Surgical Laser - We are proud to offer the use of a surgical laser, which presents a less invasive alternative to traditional surgery and thus results in less pain, swelling, bleeding, and post-operative discomfort.

Post-Operative Pain Medication - To support the comfort of your pet while he or she is healing post surgery, we offer optional pain medications for you to take home.

Microchipping - Although this can be done at any time, having your pet microchipped while under anesthesia is an ideal option.

Post-Operative Surgical Site Therapy Laser - We are proud to offer the only Class 4 Therapy Laser Machine in the Midwest Region. This laser aids the body in healing itself and is an additional treatment to the surgical site which will promote quicker healing and less pain and swelling.
